EARTHQUAKE

RESPONSE AND EVACUATION PLAN FOR GUESTS AT HÓTEL ELDHESTAR

How to stay as safe as possible during an earthquake? Be aware that some earthquakes are actually foreshocks and a larger earthquake might occur. Minimize your movements to a few steps to a nearby safe place and if you are indoors, stay there until the shaking has stopped and you are sure exiting is safe.

IF INDOORS

- DROP to the ground; take COVER by getting under a sturdy table or other piece of furniture and HOLD ON until the shaking stops. If there is no table or desk near you, cover your face and head with your arms and crouch in an inside corner of the building.
- Stay away from glass, windows, outside doors and walls, and anything that could fall, such as lighting fixtures or furniture.
- Stay in bed if you are there when the earthquake strikes. Hold on and protect your head
 with a pillow, unless you are under a heavy light fixture that could fall. In that case,
 move to the nearest safe place.
- Stay inside until the shaking stops and it is safe to go outside. Research has shown that
 most injuries occur when people inside buildings attempt to move to a different
 location inside the building or try to leave.
- Be aware that the electricity may go out or fire alarms may turn on.

FOR ESCAPE ROUTES, PLEASE REFER TO THE DIAGRAM ON THE BACK OF THE INTERIOR DOOR LEADING FROM YOUR ROOM INTO THE MAIN HALLWAY.

EARTHQUAKE

IF OUTDOORS

- · Stay there.
- Move away from buildings, streetlights, and utility wires.
- Once in the open, stay there until the shaking stops. The greatest danger exists directly outside buildings, at exits and alongside exterior walls.

IF IN A MOVING VEHICLE


- Stop as quickly as safety permits and stay in the vehicle. Avoid stopping near or under buildings, trees, overpasses, and utility wires.
- Proceed cautiously once the earthquake has stopped. Avoid roads, bridges, or ramps that might have been damaged by the earthquake.

IF TRAPPED UNDER DEBRIS

- Do not light a match.
- Do not move about or kick up dust.
- Cover your mouth with a handkerchief or clothing.
- Tap on a pipe or wall so rescuers can locate you. Use a whistle if one is available. Shout
 only as a last resort. Shouting can cause you to inhale dangerous amounts of dust.

AFTER AN EARTHQUAKE, YOU SHOULD:

- Wear shoes (if debris is on the floor).
- Do not use an open flame if there is danger of a fire starting.
- Leave your room calmly after an earthquake. Many accidents occur when people run out in panic through debris after an earthquake.
- Go to the meeting point by the flagpole in front of the Hotel and meet up with an Eldhestar staffmember and wait for further instructions.
- Dress appropriately for the weather conditions if you leave the building.
- Never touch damaged electrical poles.



FIRE

RESPONSE AND EVACUATION PLAN FOR GUESTS AT HÓTEL ELDHESTAR

IN CASE A FIRE STARTS IN YOUR ROOM

- Leave the room immediately and do not try to pack or take anything with you.
- Inform the reception about the fire and await further instructions.

IN CASE THE FIRE ALARM BELL RINGS OR SMOKE IS DETECTED:

- · Stay calm
- Leave your room through the terrace door or a window and go to the meeting point in the cafeteria at the stable, where at least one of our staff members will wait for you
- Report your name and the name of the room you were staying in. This is very important to ensure that all quests are present.
- Await further instructions

REMEMBER:

- · Fire spreads rapidly
- Fire produces thick black smoke that is difficult to see through and can cause suffocation
- The freshest air will always be near the floor
- Move quickly but do not run
- Be decisive and stick to your decisions

FOR ESCAPE ROUTES, PLEASE REFER TO THE DIAGRAM ON THE BACK OF THE INTERIOR DOOR LEADING FROM THE ROOM INTO THE MAIN HALLWAY.

Hveragerði Geothermal Park



Area in Hveragerði with boiling mud pools. It is possible to boil an egg on the rocks. Entrance fee ISK 400 per person.

Reykjadalur

The "Valley of smoke" is a beautiful hiking area just outside the village of Hveragerði. It takes around 1 – 1.5 hours to hike up from the parking lot, but then your reward is a bath in a natural hot river. No changing room. We recommend crampons in the winter. Free to visit. Parking fee.



Geysir



Easy to reach by car in approximately 50 minutes. Hot spring area which you must visit when you are in Iceland. Ask at reception for directions or map. Free to visit.

Gullfoss



One of the most beautiful waterfalls in Iceland, approximately 10 km further then Geysir. Ask at reception for directions or map. Free to visit.

Þingvellir

National park, famous for being the place where the first parliament was founded in the whole world. Also known for the transatlantic gap, growing bigger each year. Ask at reception for directions or map. Free to visit.



Kerið



A volcanic crater lake located in the Grímsnes area in south lceland, approximately a 30-minute drive from Eldhestar. It is elliptic in shape, 270 m long, 170 m wide, and 55 m deep. The pond in it is 7-10 m deep, depending on the ground water level of the area. Entrance fee ISK 400 per person to guarantee the maintenance of the site.

Krýsuvík

Situated on the Reykjanes peninsula and approximately a 1-hour drive from Eldhestar. It is in the south of Reykjanes in the middle of the fissure zone on the Mid-Atlantic Ridge which traverses Iceland diagonally from the south-west to the northeast of the island. Krýsuvík is one of Iceland's high temperature areas. This becomes visible through the sulfur springs and hot springs at Seltún and another similar area nearby. Free to visit.
